### Biosketch

Dr. David Kofler studied medicine from 1996 to 2002 at the Ludwig-Maximilians University Munich and at the University of Montpellier (France). Between 2002 and 2003 Dr. Kofler worked as a medical resident at the Medical Clinic III (Director: Professor Dr. W. Hiddemann) of the University Hospital Grosshadern in Munich. In 2003 Dr. Kofler joined the Department I of Internal Medicine at the University Hospital Cologne.

From 2010 to 2013 Dr. Kofler worked as a postdoctoral fellow in the laboratory of Professor David A. Hafler at the Center for Neurologic Diseases of the Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School and at the Department of Immunobiology at Yale University. During this time he was supported by a research grant of the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG). His research is focused on TH17 cell functions and regulatory mechanisms in autoimmune diseases.

Dr. Kofler leads the Laboratory of Molecular Immunology at the Department I of Internal Medicine of the University Hospital Cologne.
